

Terms & Conditions of Summer School:
“Different aspects of transport on Upper Silesia Region –
– Różne aspekty transportu na Górnym Śląsku”
24.06.2019 – 03.07.2019

1. Organizer

The organizer of the summer school is the Faculty of Transport, Silesian University of Technology (Poland).

2. Participant

Participants in the summer school may be students of any degree of transport and related courses from countries in Europe and other countries of the world, interested in transport issues in the industrial regions of Central and Eastern Europe.

3. The date and place of summer school

The summer school will be held on 24.06.2019 – 03.07.2019 at the Silesian University of Technology, Faculty of Transport in Katowice (Poland).

4. Goals of the summer school

- a) Acquiring knowledge in the field of transport issues in the area of Upper Silesia including aspects of the production of various means of transport, transport infrastructure facilities, the implementation of passenger and freight transport, the use of transport processes for the needs of the economy and society,
- b) Synthesis of acquired knowledge and its use in project work,
- c) Developing creativity in thinking and designing,
- d) Developing social competences and working in a group.

5. Application procedure

- a) The candidate who wants to take part in the summer school " Different aspects of transport on Upper Silesia Region – Różne aspekty transportu na Górnym Śląsku " sends his application to the organizer of the summer school by completing the online application form, available on the website: summerschool.polsl.pl / School / Transport
- b) By submitting his application, the candidate accepts the terms & conditions of summer school, available on the website summerschool.polsl.pl under the registration form, which is tantamount to a commitment to comply with its provisions.
- c) By submitting his application, the candidate accepts the privacy policy and agrees with the organizer to process and place his personal data contained in the application in the database of the Silesian University of Technology. Personal data of the candidate will be processed only by the organizer and only for needs of the summer school organization.
- d) After the organizer has successfully accepted the application, the candidate receives information about the acceptance of the application together with the data for payment transfer. At the same time, the candidate receives a link to the agreement form on the terms of payment for the training, which he is obliged to complete online and accept.
- e) The candidate is obliged to make the payment by 24.05.2019. After the payment is credited, he or she receives a written confirmation by e-mail about the admission to the summer school.

6. Fee

- a) The cost of participation in the summer school is 530 EURO per person.
- b) The price includes the fee for:

- classes
 - didactic materials necessary for the implementation of the program,
 - accommodation in a student dormitory in 2-3 person rooms from 24.06.2019 to 03.07.2019.
 - meals (9 x breakfast, 10 x lunch, 2 x supper)
 - educational trips and participation in the cultural and sightseeing program (including admission tickets)
- c) Participants pay their own travel costs to the place of training and return journey to their place of residence, individual insurance (for travel and stay), as well as costs related to obtaining a visa.
- d) The fee of **EUR 530** shall be paid in full to the following account of the organizer:

- e) The lack of the full payment fee by the participant by 24.05.2019 is treated as resignation from participation in the summer school.
- f) All candidates should withhold the booking of flight tickets and planning the trip to the summer school, until they receive a final confirmation from the organizer about the meeting of the required minimum number of participants and the start of the summer school. Such information will be sent to all accepted participants by 31.05.2019.

7. Rules for the implementation of the summer school

- a) Participants of the summer school are obliged to attend classes and take active part in additional activities planned by the organizers.
- b) Participants are required to present the presentation (part 1 prepared before arrival, part 2 completed during the summer school, 15 min / ppt) on the selected transport problem (reference of the state of affairs in the home country to the state of observation in Upper Silesia Region).
- c) If the participant completes the summer school program, he / she obtains 6 points. ECTS confirmed by a certificate.

8. The organizer's right to cancel the summer school

The organizer reserves the right to cancel the summer school if the minimum number of participants is not collected. If the minimum number of participants is not collected until 24.05.2019, the organizer notifies by e-mail the accepted candidate about not opening the summer school and in case the participant has already paid his / her fee, the University returns to the participant the whole amount of fee (530 EUR).

9. Participant's right to resign from participation

The accepted candidate who paid the fee for participation in the summer school may withdraw his application on a written request:

- a) until 24.05.2019 without any additional costs. Then the full amount of the fee will be refunded to the participant on the account provided by him.
- b) after 24.05.2019 - the payment will not be refunded to the participant.

10. Visa

- a) At the request of the participant, the organizer issues an invitation for the purposes of applying for a visa.
- b) Each participant on his own is applying for a visa and covers all costs related to obtaining a visa.

11. Additional arrangements

- a) The organizer is not responsible for the timely delivery of correspondence sent by the polish post or e-mail.
- b) In matters not covered by these Regulations, the provisions of the Civil Code, the Act on the Protection of Personal Data and the Law on Copyright and Related Rights shall apply.
